# CONTRACT

The Contract for the Hiring of On-Site Medic during the Pistang Pinoy sa Korea 2026 on 14 June 2026 ("Contract") is entered into between the **EMBASSY OF THE REPUBLIC OF THE PHILIPPINES** in Seoul ("Embassy"), with its office at 80 Hoenamu-ro, Yongsan-gu, Seoul 04346, represented by Ambassador Bernadette Therese C. Fernandez, and **DAEHAN 911 RESCUE TEAM CO., LTD.** ("On-Site Medic") with its office at 18 Gamasan-ro 48-gil, Yeongdeungpo-gu, Seoul, represented by Mr. Seong-min Lee, CEO, jointly known as "Parties".

## ***I. Scope of Work***

The Embassy agrees to enter into an agreement with the On-Site Medic to provide on-site emergency medical and ambulance services during an official event organized by the Embassy. Event details are as follows:

- a. Event Title : Pistang Pinoy sa Korea 2026
- b. Address : Seoul Battleship Park, 407 Maponaru-gil, Mapo-gu, Seoul
- c. Date : 14 June 2026 (Sunday)
- d. Time : 7:30 AM to 2:00 PM

## ***II. Qualification***

The On-Site Medic is a fully licensed basic life support provider in the Republic of Korea and agrees to perform emergency medical and ambulance services ("Services") during the event as provided in the Contract.

## ***III. Obligations of the On-Site Medic***

- a. The On-Site Medic shall dispatch and staff one (1) ambulance in a ready state to respond to on-site emergency medical service consultations and calls received by the Embassy or the participants during the event.
- b. The ambulance dispatched during the event shall meet the requirements of all applicable ROK laws, regulations and licensure standards.
- c. The On-Site Medic agrees to provide the usual, necessary and appropriate equipment and supplies required to perform the services under this Contract. The list of equipment and supplies is itemized in the terms of reference, which will form part of this Contract.
- d. The Parties agree not to differentiate or discriminate against individuals because of gender, race, color, national origin, ancestry, religion, sex, marital status, sexual preference, age, financial ability or medical condition, and the On-Site Medic agrees to render treatment and care to all persons in the same manner and in accord with the same standards as offered to other persons.

## ***IV. Personnel***

The ambulance dispatched by the on-site medic shall be staffed by one (1) certified Emergency Medical Technician, and one (1) ambulance driver with a

valid driver's license and reasonable driver and safety training. The On-Site Medic shall be neatly dressed in a recognizable uniform with their name badges visible. All duties shall be performed in a professional manner.

**V. *Indemnification and Hold Harmless***

The On-Site Medic hereby agrees to indemnify the Embassy, and to defend and hold it harmless, from all demands, claims, lawsuits, causes of actions, losses, assessments, damages, deficiencies, judgements, liabilities, costs and expenses (including interest, penalties and reasonable attorney's fees and disbursements) arising out of or in connection with any acts or omissions of the On-Site Medic in the performance of its duties and responsibilities under this Agreement.

The Embassy hereby agrees to indemnify the On-Site Medic and its affiliates, trustees, members, officers, employees and agents, and to defend and hold them harmless, from all demands, claims, lawsuits, costs and expenses (including interest, penalties and reasonable attorney's fees and disbursements) arising out of or in connection with any acts or omissions of the Embassy and/or its personnel in the performance of its duties and responsibilities under this Agreement.

**VI. *Contract Price***

The Embassy agrees to pay Four Hundred Fifty Thousand Korean Won (KRW 450,000) to the On-Site Medic, based on the scope of work and obligations of the On-Site Medic.

**VII. *Terms of Payment***

The Embassy shall deposit its payment to the On-Site Medic's bank details provided below:

**VIII. *Miscellaneous***

The Embassy and the On-Site Medic agree to the following:

- a. *No Employer-Employee Relationship.* Nothing in the contract is intended or deemed to create any employment, partnership, agency, or joint venture between the parties.
- b. *Additional Services.* Any additional services ("Additional Services") must be requested in writing by either Party and are subject to the availability of suppliers and contractors in Seoul, South Korea.
- c. *Government Auditing Rules and Regulations.* The relevant accounting and auditing rules of the Government of the Republic of

the Philippines shall cover this contract.

**X. Severability**

Should any provision of this contract be determined to be void, invalid, unenforceable, or illegal for whatever reason, such provision(s) shall be null and void; provided, however, that the remaining provisions of this contract shall be unaffected thereby and shall continue to be valid and enforceable.

**XI. Termination**

If either the Embassy or the On-Site Medic breaches its obligations under this Contract, the other party may terminate this agreement by providing the breaching party with at least thirty days' written notice, except that such notice will not lead to termination if the breaching party remedies the breach before the thirty-day period ends.

**XII. Settlement of Disputes**

Parties shall exert their best efforts to amicably settle any dispute, controversy, or claim arising from the contract or the breach, termination, or invalidity thereof.

**XIII. Observation of Laws**

Both parties shall comply with the relevant laws and regulations of the Republic of Korea and the Republic of the Philippines in performing the Contract.

**XIV. Immunity**

Nothing in the Contract shall be construed as a waiver by the Embassy of its diplomatic or consular immunity recognized under international law and national laws of the Republic of Korea.

**XV. Entire Contract**

This Contract constitutes the entire Contract between the Parties. No modification or amendment of this Contract shall be effective unless in writing and signed by both Parties.
