# PHILIPPINE FOOD DURING THE EMBASSY'S HOSTING OF THE SPECIAL LECTURE ON CYBERSECURITY AND ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE ON 20 JANUARY 2026

## Terms of Reference

The Embassy of the Philippines intends to engage the services of a reputable Caterer to prepare Filipino dishes to be served by the Embassy during its hosting of the Special Lecture on Cybersecurity and Artificial Intelligence on 20 January 2026 (Tuesday).

### *I. Background*

The Philippine Embassy will host this month's diplomatic roundtable, a special lecture on cybersecurity and artificial intelligence entitled "Harnessing Artificial Intelligence Safely: Cybersecurity, Ethics, and the Future of Digital Governance," on 20 January 2026. The roundtable will be attended by the ASEAN Ambassadors, MOFA and AKC Officials, with the Ambassador of the Republic of Estonia as guest speaker.

As host, the Embassy shall serve Filipino dishes as an opportunity for culinary diplomacy and to introduce guests to unique traditional dishes.

### *II. Event Details*

Details of the event is as follows:

- a. Date : 20 January 2026 (Tuesday)
- b. Time : 3:00 to 5:00 PM
- c. Venue : 2F Conference Room, Philippine Embassy
- d. Number of pax : 35 persons (maximum)

### *III. Scope of Work*

The Caterer shall prepare and cook the following dishes, which should be good for 35 persons:

- a. Pansit (with chicken and vegetables, absolutely no pork)
- b. Chicken Inasal
- c. Biko
- d. Cassava Cake
- e. Sapin-sapin
- f. Banana turon
- g. Buko pandan
- h. Sago't gulaman

Furthermore, the Caterer shall package the above-listed dishes in a disposable serving tray.

Depending on the agreement, the Caterer will ensure the dishes are available for pickup at the agreed time on the day of the event.

*IV. Approved Budget for the Contract*

The Approved Budget for the Contract is **One Million Seven Hundred Thousand Korean Won** (KRW 1,700,000), inclusive of all applicable fees.

*V. Terms of Payment*

The Embassy shall pay the Supplier within seven (7) days after fulfillment of the contract.
